

Recipe Corner

Mummy doesn't measure anything she just puts it all it a bowl. Preheat oven to 165 deg Celsius (329F) Rolled oats. Cinnamon shredded coconut (not desiccated coconut) almond slivers. Mix it all together. Line a baking tray with foil. Tip it onto tray and spread evenly. Drizzle with honey. Mummy does a zigzag thing. Bake for 15mins. Take out mix/turn drizzle a bit more honey. Bake 12-15mins. Take out mix it up again. Bake 12-15mins. Just keep an eye on it so it doesn't burn.

Mummy usually bakes / mixes 4-5times. And add as much honey each time as you want. When finished let it cool a bit. Tip into a bowl and just stir every so often until cool enough to put into an airtight container. Then we have it with almond milk. Yum!
