#### Meet the Plushie Weather Forecasters




Good Afternoon Friends of Plushiestan! We are honoured to be asked to be part of the latest edition of Pets Mews. As some of you probably know, we occasionally post weather forecasts mostly for UK Plushies, however, last Summer, we did keep a couple of accounts that get affected by the Hurricane Season updated by DM with the active hurricane season when there were 5 active hurricanes at the same time... "Harvey", the record breaking "Irma", "Jose", Katia and the short lived hurricane "Lee". We were kept busy in this 5-7 day period and we hoped that we made a difference to those wanting some comfort and news about their strength and direction. This year in the UK we kept UK Plushies updated with the snow events in March 2018 to the massive heatwave at the end of April where the UK experienced it's warmest April day since 1949. So let me introduce you to the team... I am Nelson Digalig, Chief Weather Forecaster, and I always feature at the centre of every photo because I am a fox and I like to be the centre of attention (of course - cunning eh?). It also means that I can get the information from both of my assistants who watch different parts of the Northern Hemisphere... Poppy is always to the right of me in the photos and is the pinker piggy of the two; she is in charge of watching for weather trends across Europe and reporting to me of any significant changes that are likely to occur in a short space of time that could affect our weather from the East. Pippa watches for any trends towards the USA and the north Atlantic and is therefore to my left

all the time; she is usually the busier of the pair as most of the UK weather comes from the west on the north Atlantic Jet Stream which can be very active at certain times of the year bringing wind, rain and a succession of low pressure systems.

#### Where did it all start?

It all started when Dad turned 10 and his Nan gave him a weather book, now known as "The Weather Bible", where he read all 575 pages cover to cover and became fascinated with it all and it escalated from there. In the two years that we have been on Instagram, we have read all the books (this is just a small selection



of them in this photo) so we are pretty much "Weather Geeks" by now, knowing all weather types, cloud types, able to read all the charts, plot rain bands. depressions, and pretty much work out where the sun is going to shine and we reckon that we can do 5-7 day weather forecasts with a good degree of accuracy. Dad started taking weather readings on the 1st January 1987 when he became the weather monitor at school and has continue to collate weather data ever since, we are pictured with the weather diaries from 2001-2011... we couldn't fit them all in so we took one decade to show you the open pages from 2001 and 2011 to show that the way he writes things down hasn't changed at all during that period of time. In fact, this has been the way he writes in the diaries since the beginning and still does now, although these days, the iPad has been used since 1st Jan 2014 to keep all the more detailed notes







Dad was the lucky one that got his picture in that paper with his "official" forecast, but without him. we wouldn't know what we know. so we let him have that one \*sigh\* So we include a couple of pictures from that week anyway

#### What does the future hold

We're not entirely sure what the future holds, but we are extremely



bust completing our first year doing an Open University degree in Environmental Science. There is another two years of this, and then, hopefully, we will take a year out to go to actual university, rather than working from home, at the University of East Anglia to get formally qualified as meteorologists and get a "real" job in the field. What we would also like to do in the future is to give you all the chance to ask us questions about the weather. It doesn't matter where you are in the world, we do have the ability to provide 5-7 day forecasts (Dad does this all the time on his FB Weather Group so we've watched him and learned a lot). And if you are affected the weather, including hurricanes, storms and the likelihood of tornadoes in America from Supercell Storms (this season is almost upon us now) or any other element that you might want more information about, then please feel free to contact us by DM on Instagram and we will be glad to help and provide a plushie weather forecast just for you.


