As we never expected a reply from them, this message with such a lovely photo from Harry & Meghan means so so much to Dörte, and me, of course.

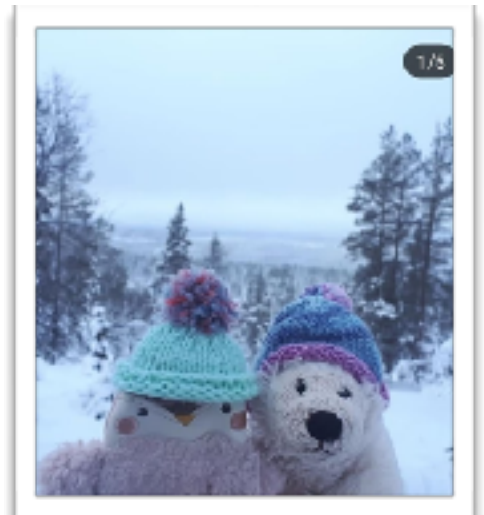
And you know what will happen when Baby Sussex makes its way into our world *lol* of course you know another card will be written to Kensington Palace.

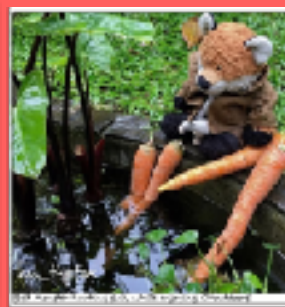


Your Good Mews Photos
