But with no further delay, here is our list of things you must do in Prague in spring.



1. Buy a Pomlazka (pictured left).

Only sold one or two weeks before Easter, the Pomlazka is made from the branches of young Willow trees. The branches are woven to make a long stick. The end of the stick is decorated with coloured strings. The Pomlazka is special because it is used for a unique tradition that happens on Easter Monday. The sticks are used to lightly tap Women. The boy Plushies taps the girl plushie with the Pomlazka to make her stronger and more beautiful. The girl plushie in return gives the boy plushie decorated eggs and some drinks.

2. Go to local gardens.

From late fall to early spring the gardens around Prague are closed. In the middle of spring they are opened. They are a real treat. Filled with amazing history they are well worth a visit. We recommend Wallenstein Garden. It is where the Czech national senate is located. It has a lovely pond, eight owls, and 4 peacocks. Here you can see William and George in Letna Park and in the Wallanstein Gardens.

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3 Watch the sunrise or the sunset from Lenta Park.


