life like that. It's a whole new perspective. But the longer I sit here on the couch with Cecilia looking at "Life", the more I begin to enjoy the view,



because I can see clearly from here: Why should tragedies only happen to others? Who are we to demand invulnerability? We are all just plushies. We are all just humans. No one of us is more special than the other. No one receives a special treatment by fate, not even those who are most special to us. I snuggle up to Cecilia and she smiles. I love being in her presence. She seems to be reconciled with life and its decisions. Her peace soothes me. So, the days go by. When she doesn't sleep, she prays or she tells me jokes. And I tell her jokes, too, without being afraid of an awkward silent moment. Cecilia is the only person in the world who laughs at my jokes. We sit on the balcony, share cake and chocolate milk, play with the little puppy who comes by from time to time ... and we talk a lot. It took a very long while until I heard Cecilia's voice again. I recognised it deep within me in a moment when I felt too small to fight for my big dream. "Why not you"? she said. "Why should it only be the others who make their dreams come true? You are just as special as they are." And I just stood there, quiet, looking at "Life" from that other beautiful point of view.




And in fashion news, @Nicimi biba (left) looks royal for @Fred says hello's competition. And @lucu0920 (right) has been twinning it in style!
