Hallo liebe Freunde. Ich bin Huhni (@huhni_world) und lebe in der schönen Stadt Görlitz. Görlitz liegt etwa 100 Kilometer östlich von Dresden an der deutsch-polnischen Grenze. Rund 56 000 Menschen leben in dieser fast 1 000 Jahre alten Stadt.

Da Görlitz im zweiten Weltkrieg wenig zerstört wurde, gibt es hier noch sehr viel schöne alte Architektur zu sehen, die besonders seit 1990 umfangreich restauriert wurde.

Hier wurden viele Szenen für bekannte Filme wie zum Beispiel „Around the World in 80 Days“, „The Reader“, „Inglourious Basterds“, „The Monuments Men“ oder „The Grand Budapest Hotel“ gedreht. So besuchten schon viele Stars aus der Traumfabrik Görlitz. Kate

Winslet, Bill Murray, Edward Norton, Ralph Fiennes, Owen Wilson, Jeff Goldblum, Willem Dafoe, Jacky Chan, Quentin Tarantino... sie alle wurden bereits in Görlitz gesichtet.

Außerdem wird in Görlitz und Umgebung die deutsche Krimiserie „Wolfsland“ gedreht.

Goerlitz is located about 100 kilometres east of Dresden on the German-Polish border. Around 56,000 people live in this almost 1,000-year-old city.

Because Goerlitz escaped relatively un-damaged in the World War II, there's still a lot of beautiful old architecture to see here, which has been extensively restored, especially since 1990.

That is why the city has been used repeatedly for decades as a location for historical or fairy tale films.



Recently, even Hollywood has become aware of Goerlitz. Many scenes were shot here for well-known films such as "Around the World in 80 Days", "The Reader", "Inglourious Basterds", "The Monuments Men" and "The Grand Budapest Hotel." Many stars from the dream factory have already visited the city of Goerlitz; Kate Winslet, Bill Murray, Edward Norton, Ralph Fiennes, Owen Wilson, Jeff Goldblum, Willem Dafoe, Jacky Chan, Quentin Tarantino ... they have all been sighted in Goerlitz.

What I particularly like about my city is the beautiful old town. Here you can go for a nice walk and admire a wide variety of architectural styles. There are plenty of pubs, cafés, ice cream shops and restaurants that invite you to linger. Every year in summer there is a big old town festival, which many visitors come to. And in winter there is a wonderful Christmas market in the same place.

The city is divided into a Polish and a German part. To Poland you can simply stroll comfortably over a pedestrian bridge. Here you will also find nice restaurants and pubs with great food and delicious beer.

By the way, we still brew the beer ourselves in Goerlitz. The



Landskron brewery, has been around since 1869 and the beer in many different types is ... delicious !!

There are many cycling and hiking trails in the area. The lake "Berzdorfer See", a former lignite mine, has also been very popular for several years. Here you can swim, do water sports or go around the lake by bike, for example. Paddle tours are offered on the border-river Neisse.

There are also many beautiful excursion destinations in the vicinity of Goerlitz, such as the Zittau Mountains, the "Fürst-Pückler-Park" Bad Muskau or the old town of Bautzen.

I love my city. It is not too big and not too small and offers a lot of variety.

Try these Nutella Chocolate Muffins as presented by
@pusheen_travels



1. Combine all the wet ingredients first: eggs with sugar, mix well; add in the milk and melted butter, mix well
2. Sift the dry ingredients into the mixture: plain flour, cocoa powder and baking soda, fold and mix well
3. Pour the batter into the muffin pans, about two-thirds of each cup, add in a teaspoon of Nutella, and fill up the cup with more batter
4. Bake for 20 mins at 170 degrees Celsius and leave muffins to cool
5. Serve the Muffins! Goes well with any tea, but we recommend French Earl Grey!
