

HISTORY (short- for more Information: https://www.samaritans-purse.org.uk/what-we-do/operation-christmas-child) Operation Christmas Child began in the UK in 1990, after Dave Cooke, a local businessman in Wrexham and his wife Jill felt called to do something in response to the plight of Romanian orphans at the end of the Cold War. After actively partnering with Samaritan's Purse for two years, the Wales-based shoebox gift project became an official project of Samaritan's Purse in 1995.

Since 1990, more than 178 million children in more than 150 countries have received an Operation Christmas Child shoebox There are INTERNATIONAL HEADQUARTERS in Australia, Canada, Germany, Korea and United Kingdom

How to Pack a Shoebox

- 1. Find a Shoebox-wrap it in nice paper or order preprinted shoeboxes
- 2. Fill with gifts- fun toys, hygiene items and school supplies, cuddly toy....
- 3. (Make your project donation)
- 4. Personalise & Pray- Personalise your shoebox by including a hand written note
- 5. Drop Off Your Shoebox- Your nearest Drop-off Location is listed on the homepage
