I recently finished *Where the Drowned Girls Go* by Seanan McGuire, the 7th instalment of the *Wayward Children Series*. The Series follows the exploits of many different children who have stumbled through magic doors into other worlds. Some of the books are set in the school for the children who have come back, while others are in the various magical worlds. This latest instalment is following Cora, who we've met in previous instalments, as she transfers schools from Elanor West's Home for Wayward Children, where all the students yearn to return to their magical worlds, to the Whitethorn Institute, where the students want to forget, or is it really their choice.

This fast-paced read is an exciting and fun mystery, beginning to end. While the world is richer if you read the whole series, I feel as though most books can stand alone and still captivate.
