

Reviews of Adventure Books!

The Mostly True Story of Tanner and Louise by Colleen Oakley (2023)

Tanner is 21 years old and miserable. An injury has put an end to her sports career and she had to quit college. She needs somewhere to live, so when she is offered a job as a live-in caregiver for 84 year old Louise, she accepts. Louise isn't happy about it, but after falling once, her children insist on this. But Tanner soon realises that not much is as it seems. Strange things are going on in the house, and Louise is very secretive. Then one night, Louise suddenly demands that Tanner must drive them both out of the city in her old car, hinting that there will be no going back.

Tanner and Louise forge a strong bond while a very unlikely but yet intriguing story about Louise's life unfolds. This book reminds us that every person has many layers and it is worth it to try to get to know someone you might at first dismiss thinking that they are too old or too different from oneself.

The Hundred-Year-Old Man Who Climbed Out the Window and Disappeared by Jonas Jonasson (2009)

Allan Karlsson does not want to celebrate his 100th birthday. A big party is planned, but instead of joining it he simply climbs out of the window of his nursing home and sets off. Without a plan and just by accident, he suddenly finds himself on the run from both criminals and the police. At the same time as he runs away, makes new acquaintances, and thereby goes on one more, maybe last, adventure of his long life, all the unlikely things he has experienced throughout the years are revealed.

The book explains how Allan played a part in many of the great events that shaped the world during the 1900s. He traveled around the whole planet, met many important people, and even influenced politicians and helped develop some of the most important inventions of this time. If it is true. The reader can't always tell, but it still sure is an extraordinary story.

West with Giraffes by Lynda Rutledge (2021)

In 1938, Woody Nickel is a poor teenager without hopes for the future. His family perished during the depression and he is left on his own. He happens to be at the New York harbour when two giraffes, delivered from Africa, are unloaded at the docks. Woody just knows that he has to be with the giraffes, at all costs, and so he sets off after them. It turns out that the majestic animals are going to be driven across the country, to the San Diego Zoo, and Woody gets to be a part of the crew working with them.

What could possibly be exciting about driving two giraffes from coast to coast in a truck in the USA in 1939? Everything, as it turns out! One problem after another occurs, but Woody and the Old Man responsible for the transport never give up. The book is hard to put down, because you can't wait to see what happens next and how it will all end.

Around the World in Eighty Days by Jules Verne (1873)

The British gentleman Phileas Fogg makes a bet with fellow club members in London. He will prove that it is possible to travel around the world in just 80 days. Fogg's new French valet, Passepartout, becomes his travel companion. As they set off, they are also chased by a British police detective, who thinks that Fogg is a bank robber. During their travels, they meet new cultures and people that give them the most unexpected experiences, while also at times making it difficult for them to travel as fast as necessary to win the bet. The whole journey is a race against time, which adds to the feeling of adventure.

This is a real classic that is still entertaining today. We might wonder at the world from the past and how all this was possible without the internet and modern modes of transportation, but it is also a reminder that once we set our mind on doing something, great adventures might be ahead.

Universal Parks: Adventures

New Adventures Call!

It's an exciting time to be a Universal Studios parks fan. Next year, a Universal park aimed at kids will open in Frisco, Texas, and in the early 2030s, a brand new park is scheduled to open in the UK. This year, Universal opens Epic Universe, a highly anticipated expansion to its Orlando theme parks. I have been closely following the creation of this park since it was a mere idea. After 6 years of watching patent releases, concept art, and aerial photo construction updates, I finally got the chance to step through the portals and experience this park for myself during a Passholder preview. Epic Universe features 5 "worlds" (lands), themed to Super Mario/Donkey Kong, Fantastic Beasts/Harry Potter, How to Train Your Dragon, Universal's classic monsters, and astronomy.

The park features 13 rides, 2 world-class theatrical shows, and several interactive attractions. Each of the 4 major worlds is highly immersive, completely surrounding your senses with buildings, music, food, merchandise, and walk-around characters that interact with you—making you truly feel as though you have stepped into another world. Epic Universe features some of the most advanced animatronics and puppets ever created, especially in the Isle of Berk. Moving, adorable dragons lurk around every corner, dozing with sheep or poking their heads out of their homes to say hi to guests. Universal found a way not only to utilize the Boston Dynamics robot dog technology, but also found a way to make them less creepy by encasing them in baby dragon suits, resulting in an adorable mini show experience.

n the Wizarding World, Fantastic Beasts (including Nifflers, like me!) hang out in window displays and come to life on stage in Le Cirque Arcanus, a live performance highlighting the evils of animal exploitation. I was unable to ride this world's main attraction on my visit, but I look forward to eventually stepping through the Metro-Floo and traveling to the Ministry of Magic, recreated in astounding scale as seen in the Harry Potter films. All around the world were emblems of magical creatures, in shop signs to cash registers. It's easy to miss how truly detailed this world is.

Super Nintendo World is a clone of the one in Japan, and twice the size of the one in Hollywood. Here, you can actually ride through the Mario Kart video game and "jump" over "gaps" in the "track" on Donkey Kong's Mine Cart Madness roller coaster (your actual coaster track is beneath the fake track you are simulated to be riding on). The classic monsters world, Dark Universe, has buildings dark and sinister, like a haunted European sleepy village. I spook easily so I did not spend much time here. It was truly special and surreal, getting to finally step into this brand new park. It seems only yesterday it was a piece of concept art, a pile of rubble.

But it's here, and what a time to be alive. Epic Universe will not change your life. You may even like other parks more than this new one. But it's stunning, magical, special. It sets the bar high for all new theme parks and attractions, and it is truly a dream come true for me. I still can't believe it's here and I've gone there and that I'm going again in June. Epic Universe opens officially on May 22, 2025.
